2nd Grade Supply List – Geneva Platt R. Spencer Elementary School **2019-2020**

To help make the transition to second grade easier for you and your child, please bring the following supplies to Open House, Thursday, August 22, 2019 from 4:00-5:00pm, or send the following supplies with your child on the first day of school:

1. **5 FOLDERS** - (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green w/ 2 pockets & prongs for different subjects; 1 – “Take Home” **POLY** (plastic) folder w/ 3 holes & 2 pockets - child's choice). The “Take Home” folder will be used in your child's **Daisy Binder**.
2. **2 - WHITE 3 RING BINDERS - 1 INCH ONLY** (with a clear cover pocket). These binders will be your child's **Daisy Binder** and **Writing Binder**.
3. **POUCH** - Must have 3 holes and zipper to be used in their **Daisy Binder**. Pouches are used to hold money, notes, flashcards, etc.
4. **1 PACKAGE of DURABLE CLEAR PAGE PROTECTORS** (25 count)
5. **4 - 70 COUNT NOTEBOOKS** (red, blue, yellow, & green for different subjects)
6. **PENCILS** - 4 packages of 24 yellow wooden #2 lead with an eraser.
7. **CRAYONS** - 3 boxes of 24 colors. Please no more than 24 in each.
8. **GLUE** - 1 small bottle of liquid glue and 4 glue sticks. Different projects require different glue.
9. **POINTED SCISSORS** - Please be sure your child can cut with them.
10. **RULER** - Non-flexible with inches and centimeters on it.
11. **PENCIL/SCHOOL BOX** - Only 1 box. Standard size (8" x 5").
12. **3-LARGE BOXES OF TISSUES TO SHARE**.
13. **HEADPHONES** (Requirement for Testing and Daily Use-Please put in labeled baggy). **NO Earbuds**.
14. **ANTIBACTERIAL WIPES** – Clorox (at least 35 count)
15. **FINE LINE (SKINNY) DRY ERASE MARKERS**- Package of 4. Make sure the package has at least one black marker.
16. **CLEAN SOCK or ERASER** - used to erase the dry erase boards.
17. **PLASTIC BAGS ONE BOX-QUART, SNACK, OR GALLON SIZE SLIDER PLASTIC BAGS**
(last name begins with A-K = quart size, last name L-O = snack size, last name P-Z = gallon size)
18. **CRAYOLA MARKERS** - 8 COUNT PACKAGE OF CLASSIC CRAYOLA MARKERS (1 package of skinny & 1 package of wide)
19. **BABY WIPES** – Box of 64 count
20. **4 - ERASERS** (large size)
21. **2 - SHARPIE MARKERS** (black/regular size)
22. **SNACK** for 30 students

NOTE: The supplies are for classroom use. Please do not write your child's name on them as they will be collected at the beginning of the year and handed out as needed (exceptions: glue, crayons, crayon box, headphones, & ruler.)
