## Two-Hour Delay and School Closings

- ◆ If school will be delayed or closed for weather related reasons:
- ◆ The superintendent will strive to make a decision by 5:30AM. An announcement will be made to the media and an automated telephone call will be made to parents.
- ◆ If weather conditions continue to deteriorate, a decision to close schools will be made no later than 7:30am..
- ◆ **AM Kindergarten will be cancelled.**
- ◆ Morning bus transportation will be delayed approximately two hours.
- ◆ Buses arrive at GPS at 10:30 AM.
- ◆ Parents may drop off students at GPS at 10:30 AM.
- ◆ School starts at 10:45 AM.
- ◆ No breakfast will be served.
- ◆ Lunch program will remain on the normal schedule.

## Student Arrival

Students in grades 3-5 who are eating breakfast may enter the building at 8:25am using the south office entrance. All other students may enter the building starting at 8:30am. Please do not drop off your students prior to these times, as he or she will be left unattended.

If you choose to park in the lot in the morning, you need to escort your child across the walkway. Simply dropping them off in the parking lot is not safe as there are still cars driving through it. If using the car line, please exit quickly as to not hold up the other drivers. Feel free to use the north playground entrance if it is more convenient for you for morning drop off. The doors open at 8:30am at the north playground entrance.
