Scale for Rating the Behavior Characteristics of Superior Students – Art (part V), Drama (part VII), Music (part VI)

- Screening (grades K –12): score of
 - Music = 25-33
 - Artistic = 40-53
 - Dramatic=36-47
- Identification (grades K-12): score of
 - Music = 34+
 - Artistic = 53+
 - Dramatic = 48+

Gifted and Talented Evaluation Scale (GATES)

(Section 5, items 41-50)

- Screening (grades K –12): score of 65-77
- Identification (grades K-12): score of 78+
