Fall Party

Our fall party will celebrate, Halloween or "Spooky Fun", where the students can wear their costumes and participate in a parade. The parade will begin at 1:45pm. Each teacher or grade level will send home guidelines of whether or not the students should come to school in their costume or change at school. **Parents may not drop off costumes that day. Please plan ahead.**

Please keep the guidelines below in mind when selecting a costume. Students are not permitted to have a costume or make-up that looks like blood. Students are not permitted to bring in any weapons that may go with their costume.

Masks will not be

permitted. It is our goal that all of our students will enjoy our parade and parties, but not at the expense of scaring anyone. These types of costumes can be saved for their nightly activities. Also, please remember that you may all join us for the parade, but **only** parents who have volunteered ahead of time with the classroom teacher may attend the party. Siblings are not permitted at any of the parties.

Student Arrival

Students in grades 3-5 who are eating breakfast may enter the building at 8:25am. All other students may enter the building starting at 8:30am. Please do not drop off your students prior to these times, as he or she will be left unattended.

Parade Route

Students will exit through the front southeast doors starting with fifth grade and then followed by each descending grade. The fifth grade teachers and their students will lead the parade across the front walk, turn right (head north) along the building, and then make a final right on the north walk. The students will all re-enter the building using the northeast doors.

Parents are allowed to watch along the drive throughout the parade route. Please arrive early as parking will be limited at the school. There may be available spots across the street.

In the event of inclement weather, the parade will take place inside, and parents can line the main hallway.




