

Middle School Courses for High School Credit

You are enrolled in a course that is for high school credit. During your course at the Middle School, your course-work will be graded on the Middle School grading scale and appear on your report card as such. Once this course has been transferred to the high school, the final percentage will be translated into the high school grading scale and placed on your high school transcript as such. This course will remain on your transcript throughout your high school career and calculate into your final *GPA* & Rank. The high school grading scale is as below.

For Example: If you receive and A as a final grade on your eighth grade report card with a 91%, your high school transcript will show an A- for the course OR if you receive an A as a final grade on your eighth grade report card with a 97%, your high school transcript will show an A+.
