Communicable Disease

When your child is contagious, we must be able to contact you. If you are unable to take a call during the day, an alternate contact must be provided. If these arrangements are not made, it becomes a matter of neglect.

Spreading of communicable disease is difficult to control if your child is kept waiting at school because there is no way to contact you.

A child who has lice, may not be transported on a bus. He/she must be picked up from school and checked back into school by the nurse or principal to be cleared for return.

If lice is discovered when your child is at home, please contact the school. It will help us to take steps necessary to control the spread of this nuisance. Thank you!

Please do not call the school to obtain this information. Thank you.

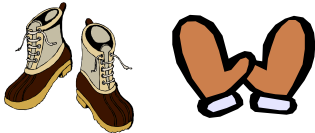
